Red Bird Mission is a year-round work opportunity for volunteers in mission and service-minded groups. Work Camp strives to provide home repair for low-income community residents and maintenance for the Mission buildings and grounds while growing in Christian love. Red Bird Mission Work Camps are geared towards High School students and adults. Some examples of work projects are roof replacement, small room additions, painting, building porches or ramps, and grounds keeping. Other light duty work is available such as cutting soup labels, office work, craft and community store helpers, and recycling.

The cost of the mission trip is \$350.00 which includes meals, lodging, and basic project supplies. Fund raising is currently underway to help offset the cost of the trip. Individuals planning on attending the mission trip must turn in a \$175.00 deposit and completed parental consent/medical form by Sunday, February 19, 2012 and be prepared to help with upcoming fund raiser events.
